

Butterfly



Black PIPING

1. Pipe a large dot for the head of the butterfly. Use your scribe to settle any points or bumps.



Black PIPING

2. Outline the body.



Black PIPING

3. Immediately fill in the body, wiggling/settling any bumps with your scribe.



Black PIPING

4. Pipe lines for the antennae, starting from the head and applying more pressure as you reach the end (To create the bulge.)



Light Teal PIPING

5. Pipe outlines for the upper wings.



Dark Teal PIPING

6. Pipe outlines for the lower wings.



Light Teal MEDIUM (20sec)

7. Flood one of the upper wings.



Light Purple FLOOD

8. Quickly pipe a line from the center outward, applying slightly more pressure at the end to increase the thickness of the line.



Dark Purple FLOOD

9. Pipe a series of small dots in the still wet icing.

Butterfly (cont.)



Dark Teal MEDIUM (20sec)

10. With the base icing still wet, pipe a single dot near the bottom outside edge



Orange FLOOD

11. Immediately pipe a smaller dot inside the dot you just created.



Varied Colors FLOOD

12. Create a mirror image of the same design on the other upper wing.

(Allow icing to dry or form a hard crust)



Dark Teal MEDIUM (20sec)

13. Fill in one of the lower wings.



Dark Purple & Light Teal FLOOD

14. In the still wet icing, pipe a large purple dot and then a smaller teal dot inside of it.



Varied Colors FLOOD

15. Create a mirror image of your work for the other lower wing.

(Allow icing to dry completely)



Orange PIPING

16. Pipe a line from the center of the upper-wing out to the top-outer corner.



Orange PIPING

17. Pipe two smaller lines near the end of the first line.



Orange PIPING

18. Pipe a line from the same starting point out to the bottom-outside corner. Add a second smaller line at the end.

Butterfly (cont.)



Orange PIPING

19. Pipe a mirror image of the same details on the other upper wing.



Light Purple PIPING

20. Pipe a line from the top-center of the lower wing out to the edge. Pipe a second small line (as shown).



Light Purple PIPING

21. Pipe a line from the same starting point as the previous step, working out toward the bottom edge. Pipe a second line (as shown).



Light Purple PIPING

22. Pipe a mirror image of these details on the opposite lower wing.
