

## Envelope



White PIPING

1. Outline the edge of the cookie, overlapping your icing at the inside angles to keep them sharp.



White FLOOD

2. Fill in the area you just outlined.

*(Allow to dry for at least 3-4 hours or 20 minutes in a dehydrator)*



White PIPING

3. Pipe an upside-down V to create the inside creases of the envelope.



White PIPING

4. Pipe an outline around the remainder of the outside edge.



Edible Ink Pen

5. If you wish to write a message, an edible ink pen (like the Rainbow Dust food pen) is a quick and easy option.



Varied Colors PIPING

6. If you're a little more confident with piping letters, try writing a message with piping icing or a combination of pen and icing.

Add a small heart by pressure piping two upside-down teardrops that connect at a bottom point.
