

Tulip



Dark Green PIPING

1. Pipe an outline for the top portion of the stem.



Light Green PIPING

2. Outline the bottom portion of the stem.



Dark Purple PIPING

3. Outline the 3 large petals, starting with the middle petal, followed by the 2 side petals.



Light Purple PIPING

4. Pipe outlines of the two smaller petals.



Varied Colors PIPING

5. With corresponding piping colors, pipe squiggly lines inside each section.



Dark Green MEDIUM (20sec)

6. Flood the top section of the stem.



Light Purple FLOOD

7. Flood the two small petals, using your scribe to pull icing down toward the narrow bottom point.

(Allow to dry or form a hard crust)



Dark Purple PIPING

8. Pipe a line on top of the middle petal's existing outline. This higher barrier will help the petal stand out more once it's flooded. (This was also a chance to fix an earlier mistake by making the middle petal a little taller).



Light Green FLOOD

9. Fill in the lower stem.

Tulip (cont.)



Dark Purple FLOOD

10. Fill in the two outside petals.

(Allow icing to dry or form a hard crust)

Dark Purple FLOOD

11. Fill in the middle petal.

(Allow icing to dry or form a hard crust)

Light Purple PIPING

12. Pipe 3 curved lines on the left petal, working from bottom to top (lines should meet at the tip of the petal).



Light Purple PIPING

13. Repeat with 2 curved lines on the middle petal.



Light Purple PIPING

14. Repeat with 3 curved lines along the outside edge of the right petal.



Dark Green PIPING

15. Pipe a series of lines to give texture to the top section of the stem.



Black PIPING

16. Pipe elongated upside-down teardrops above the petals (as shown). Since you'll outline AND fill with thick piping icing, you should use your scribe to quickly wiggle and settle any lumps & bumps.



Black PIPING

17. Pipe a second set of teardrops so that they are clustered in pairs.



Black PIPING

18. Pipe sets of small curved lines next to your teardrop shapes.

Tulip (cont.)



Black PIPING

19. Pipe sets of small dots at the top of the cookie.



Dark Purple PIPING

20. Pipe a few more dots (as shown) to add a bit more texture.
