Decorating Guide

Key



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.
(More details in full video)



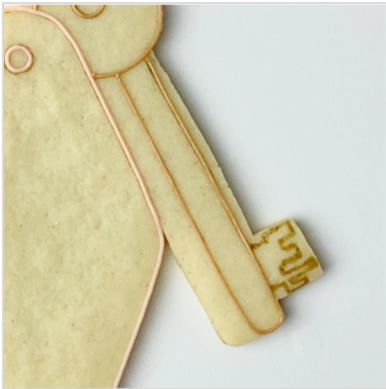
Pink PIPING

2. Outline the tag as well as the small circle inside the tag.



Brown PIPING

3. Outline the top (inner and outer) circles of the key.



Brown PIPING

4. Outline the long middle section of the key.



Brown PIPING

5. Pipe a series of small straight lines to outline the bottom section of the key.



Brown PIPING

6. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each section of the key.



Pink FLOOD

7. Fill in the tag, not including the inner circle.



Brown FLOOD

8. Fill in the long middle section of the key.



9. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.

Key (cont.)



Brown FLOOD

10. Fill in the top of the key, not including the inner circle.



Brown FLOOD

11. Fill in the bottom section of the key, being careful not to overflow the very narrow sections.



12. Allow the icing to dry completely (several hours at minimum).



Edible Ink Pen

13. If you do not plan to pipe with a projector, transfer template details using the tissue paper method. (Details in full video)



Brown PIPING

14. Pipe a narrow rectangle on top of the key's mid-section and immediately fill w/ the same icing (tip at surface/wiggle to settle).



Red PIPING

15. Pipe an outline just a few millimeters inside the edge of the pink tag.



Red PIPING

16. Pipe a circle along the edge of the small inner circle.



Red PIPING

17. Pipe outlines for the inner and outer hearts.



Red PIPING

18. Pipe a series of horizontal lines at the top of the tag. Pipe one horizontal and multiple vertical lines at the bottom of the tag.

Key (cont.)



Edible Ink Pen

19. Write the small words shown. The larger word "Love" and the number "2" will be done with piping icing.



Red PIPING

20. Cut the tip of your bag slightly bigger to create a thicker line. Pipe over the traced "Love" letters.



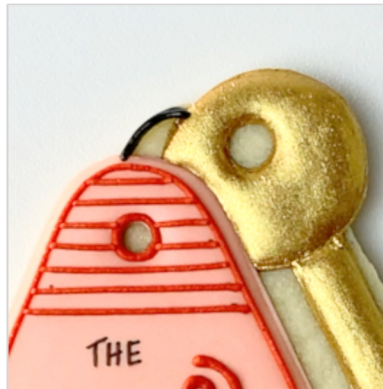
Teal PIPING

21. Pipe over the traced number "2".



Metallic (gold) paint

22. Making sure the key icing is fully dry, paint over the key. (More details in full video)



Black PIPING

23. Pipe a curved line along the upper, bare edge of the cookie. Pipe multiple lines on top of each other to create height (see video).



Black PIPING

24. Pipe a semi-circle from the inside edge of the tag's inner circle, then piping on top of the previously piped black lines, and ending inside the inner circle of the key.



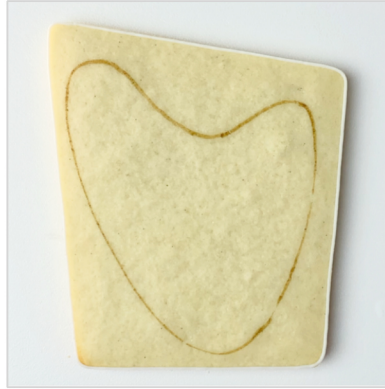

Plaque



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.
(More details in full video)



White PIPING

2. Pipe a line around the outer edge of the cookie.



Pink PIPING

3. Pipe a line along the traced outline for the retro heart shape.



White FLOOD

4. Fill in the area between the outer edge of the cookie and the heart shape. Work from the edge and flood inward.



Pink FLOOD

5. With the white icing still wet fill in the inner heart shape, working from the edge of the heart and flooding inward.



Mint PIPING

6. In the still-wet white icing, pipe starbursts and dots at top-center and bottom-left.



7. Allow the icing to dry completely.



Black PIPING

8. Use the tissue paper method or your projector to transfer a quote from the template. Pipe lines over your traced or projected letters.



Red PIPING

9. Pipe an outline that mimics the heart shape but is off-set slightly to the right,

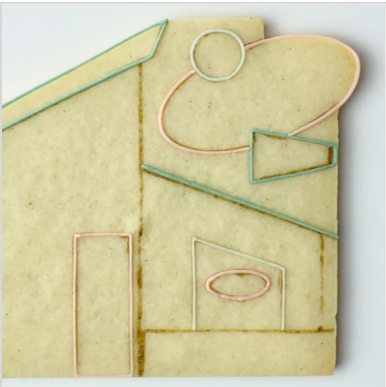

Food Marker

Pink PIPING

4. Outline the door (including the bottom edge) as well as the large oval sign and a small oval in the right window.



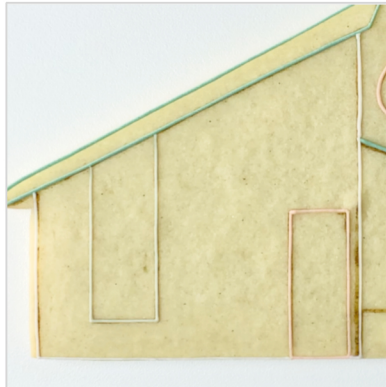
Taupe PIPING

7. Pipe an outline for the low wall (lower right side of cookie) making sure to pipe a line for the left side of the wall as well.



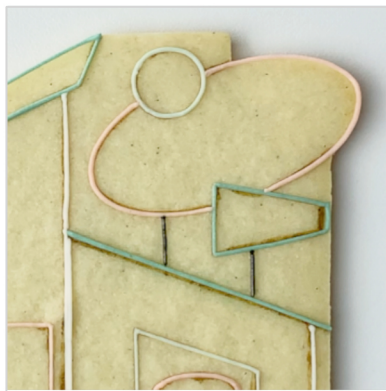
Teal PIPING

2. Outline the left roof, the lower portion of the sign, and pipe a line for the right roof.



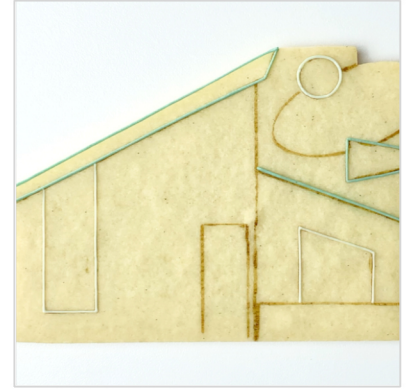
White PIPING

5. Pipe an outline around the larger left building, including the bottom edge.



Black PIPING

8. Pipe two vertical lines connecting the bottom of the sign to the top of the right roof.



Mint PIPING

3. Outline the left and right windows as well as the top circle of the sign.



White PIPING

6. Pipe lines on the right and left sides of the small right building.



Varied Colors PIPING

9. Using colors that coordinate with each section, pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the sections shown.

Motel (cont.)



Red PIPING

10. Pipe and fill a small heart near the top of the left window.



Mint FLOOD

11. With the red icing still wet, fill in the left window. Start around the edge of the heart and work outward.



White FLOOD

12. With the mint icing still wet, fill in the body of the left building. Start around the window and work rightward, flooding around the door last.



Pink FLOOD

13. With the white icing still wet, fill in the door. Use your scribe to manipulate the icing if any lines need to be straightened.

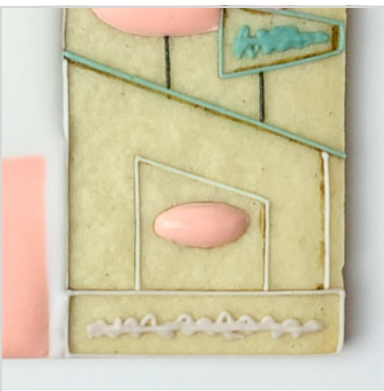


Pink FLOOD

14. Fill in the middle oval of the sign.

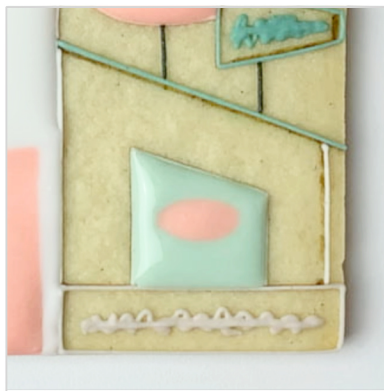


15. Allow icing to dry or crust over.



Pink FLOOD

16. Fill in the small oval in the right window.



Mint FLOOD

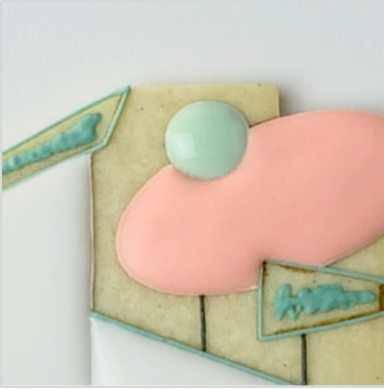
17. With the pink icing still wet, fill in the right window. Start around the edge of the oval and work outward.



White FLOOD

18. With the mint icing still wet, fill in the body of the right building. Start around the window and work outward.

Mint FLOOD

19. Fill in the top circle of the sign.



Teal FLOOD

20. Fill in the small bottom section of the sign.



Teal FLOOD

21. Fill in the left roof.



22. Allow icing to dry or crust over.



Taupe FLOOD

23. Fill in the lower right wall.



24. Allow icing to dry completely.



Edible Ink Pen

25. Using a projector or the transfer methods discussed in video, mark your dry icing with dots/lines to indicate placement of wall/roof, door details, and "Love" lettering.



Teal PIPING

26. Pipe an outline for the interior/left roof line.



Teal PIPING

27. Pipe a straight line along the bottom edge of the left roof.

Teal PIPING

28. Pipe a border along the top and left sides of the teal sign in order to add some definition.



Teal PIPING

29. Pipe a crater-preventing line along the interior length of the inner/left roof.



Taupe PIPING

30. Pipe an outline around the interior stone wall, including the section above and the one below the roof.



Taupe PIPING

31. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside the top and bottom section of the wall.



Taupe PIPING

32. Pipe a line along the top edge of the lower right wall to add some definition.



Taupe FLOOD

33. Fill in the top and bottom sections of the large stone wall.



34. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Black PIPING

35. Pipe outlines around each window. Also pipe the lines shown on the interior of the left window.



Pink PIPING

36. Pipe lines along the top, left, and right sides of the door. If you wish to pipe the pattern shown inside the door, refer to video for further guidance.

Motel (cont.)



Brown PIPING

37. Pipe a vertical line along the right edge of the door to create a long door handle.



Red PIPING

38. Pipe a series of radiating lines along the upper edge of the top circle sign.



Taupe PIPING

39. Pressure pipe sets of random stone shapes on both walls. Allow "stones" to crust before piping adjacent stones.



White PIPING

40. Pipe a lattice pattern to the right of the door. Pipe three vertical lines to start. If you wish to create the diamond pattern refer to video.



Teal FLOOD

41. Fill in the inner/left roof.



42. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Edible Ink Pen

43. Using your pen, write the words "The", "Shack", and "Open" on the signs. Also draw two lines to connect the "Open" sign to the top of its window.



Edible Ink Pen

44. Draw a line to connect the heart to the top of its window. Draw a series of lines of varying lengths with dots at the end of each to create a retro "sputnik-style" pendant.



Red PIPING

45. Pipe over your traced lines to write the word love.

Motel (cont.)



Red PIPING

46. Pipe a small heart on the sign by pressure-piping two tear drops that join at the bottom.



Mint PIPING

47. Pipe a starburst and dots to add a little more pizzazz to your sign.



Green, Teal, Pink PIPING

48. Pressure-pipe the plants and cacti shown. (See full video for detailed instruction)



Black, White, Brown, Taupe PIPING

49. Pressure-pipe a series of tiny pebbles of varied colors (primarily taupe) along the lower left edge.



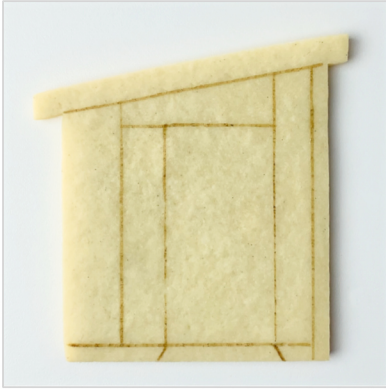
Gold Paint

50. Paint the door handle gold.



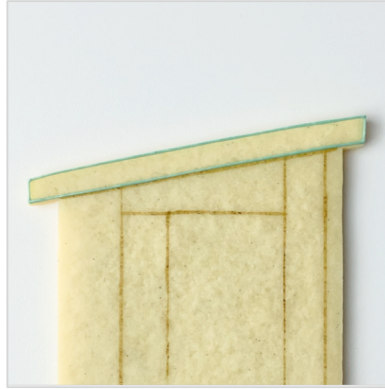

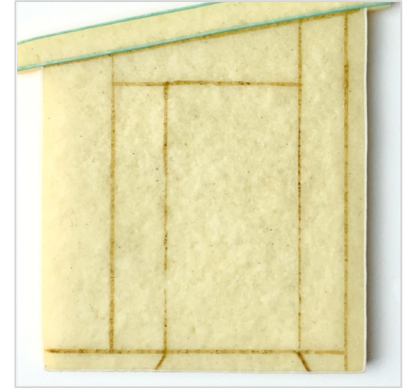
Food Marker

Teal PIPING

2. Outline the roof.



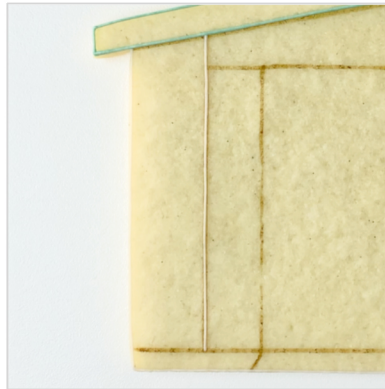
Taupe PIPING

3. Pipe around the edge of the building, including the bottom edge.



Taupe PIPING

4. Pipe a vertical line near the right edge.



Taupe PIPING

5. Pipe a vertical line inside the left edge.



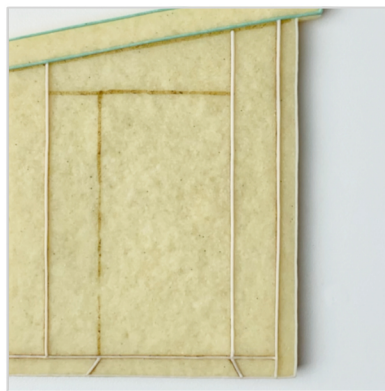
Taupe PIPING

6. Pipe a horizontal line just above the bottom edge.



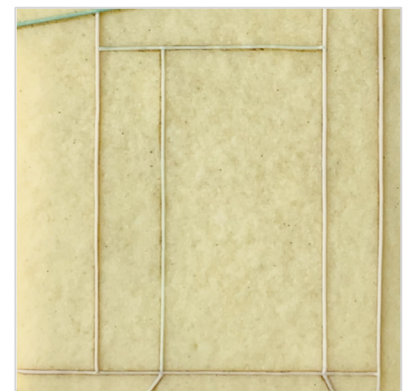
Taupe PIPING

7. Pipe two slanted lines near the bottom (below the door).



White PIPING

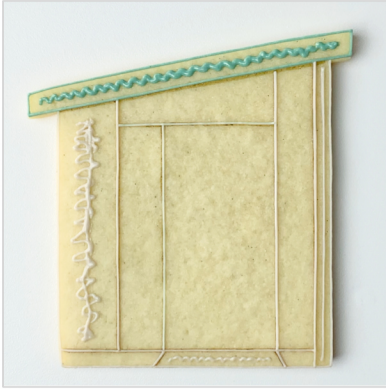
8. Pipe a vertical line to the right of the door.



Mint PIPING

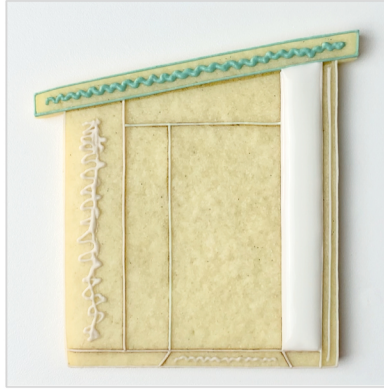
9. Pipe a horizontal line above the door and a vertical line to the left of the door.

Door (cont.)



Varied Colors PIPING

10. Using colors that coordinate with each section, pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the roof, the step, and the left and right-most vertical areas.



White FLOOD

11. Fill in the white panel just to the right of the door. Work from right to left as you flood.



Pink FLOOD

12. With the white icing still wet, fill in the door. Start flooding along the right edge first.



Mint FLOOD

13. With the pink and white icings still wet, fill in the windows above and to the left of the door.



14. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Taupe FLOOD

15. Fill in the vertical walls on the left and right edges, as well as the step below the door.



16. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Teal FLOOD

17. Fill in the roof.



18. Allow the icing to dry completely.

Door (cont.)



Scribe Tool or Edible Ink Pen

19. With icing fully dried, use the template to mark key details with dots from your pen or by gently twisting your scribe into icing. (Full video makes this step clearer)



Teal PIPING

20. Pipe two parallel lines near the bottom edge of the roof.



Taupe PIPING

21. Pipe a horizontal line along the top edge of the step. (difficult to see here)



Black PIPING

22. Pipe two vertical lines and one horizontal line around the door/windows (as shown).



Black PIPING

23. Outline the shape for a small planter to the left of the door by piping a half circle and 3 straight lines for legs.



Brown PIPING

24. Outline the shape for the light sconce and immediately fill in with the same piping icing. (Tip: connect the dots from Step 19)



Brown PIPING

25. Outline the number plate to the left of the door by piping a narrow rectangle.



Pink PIPING

26. Pipe a pattern of parallel lines on the door (as shown). (Tip: connect the dots from Step 19)



Brown PIPING

27. Pipe a long door handle with a starburst shape near its center.

Door (cont.)



Black, White, Brown, Taupe PIPING

28. Pressure-pipe a series of tiny pebbles of varied colors (primarily taupe) along the lower edge on either side of the step.



Taupe PIPING

29. Pressure-pipe sets of random stone shapes on the left wall. Allow "stones" to crust before piping adjacent stones.



Black PIPING

30. Fill in the center of the planter. Pressure-pipe and wiggle the icing with your tip to settle it.



Brown FLOOD

31. Fill in the number plate with a scant amount of flood icing so that it remains fairly flat (not puffy).

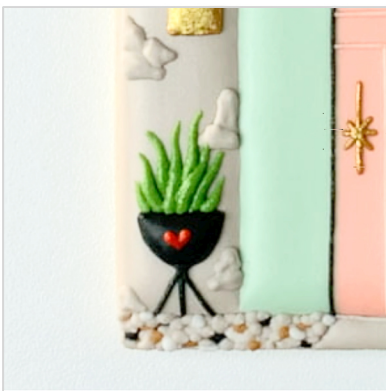


32. Allow the icing to dry completely.



Gold Paint

33. Making sure your icing is very dry, paint the light sconce, number plate, and door handle.



Green (and red) PIPING

34. Pressure-pipe tall and narrow leaves inside the planter. Allow each leaf to crust before piping adjacent leaves.

Optional: pressure-pipe a small heart on the planter.



Black PIPING

35. Pipe numbers on the gold number plate.

Palm Tree



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie. (More details in full video)



Green PIPING

2. Pipe the center or edge line for each leaf (as shown).



Green PIPING

3. Pipe the notched edges of each leaf. Do not pipe the top edge for the three double-edged leaves.



Teal PIPING

4. Pipe the notched upper portion of each double leaf.



Mint PIPING

5. Pipe an outline around the top portion of the trunk.



Taupe PIPING

6. Pipe an outline around the lower portion of the trunk.



Taupe and Mint PIPING

7. Using colors that coordinate with each section, pipe crater-preventing squiggles in both sections of the trunk.



Taupe FLOOD

8. Fill in the bottom section of the trunk.



Brown PIPING

9. In the still wet taupe icing, pipe small dots along the left edge.

Palm Tree (cont.)



Mint FLOOD

10. With the bottom of the trunk still wet, fill in the top section of the trunk.



Taupe FLOOD

11. In the still-wet mint icing, pipe a random assortment of lines of varying length. (the flood icing will spread a little bit)



Brown PIPING

12. With the icing still wet, pipe thin brown lines just below each of the taupe lines you just piped.

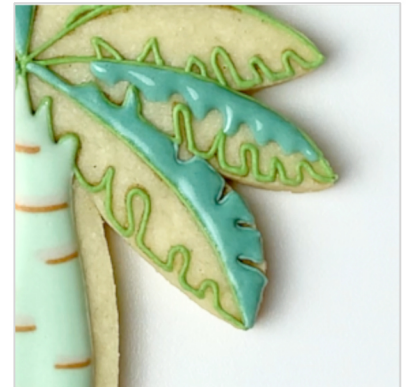


13. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Teal FLOOD

14. Fill in the top section of each of the three double-edged leaves. Take care not to overflow the notched areas.



Teal FLOOD

15. Partially flood the top edge of one of the remaining leaves with a few random squiggles.



Green FLOOD

16. With the icing from the prior step still wet, fill in the bottom of the leaf.



Teal and Green FLOOD

17. Repeat the two previous steps for each of the remaining leaves.



18. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.

Palm Tree (cont.)



Green PIPING

19. Optional: Pipe over the mid-line or edge line of each leaf to add a little definition.



Brown PIPING

20. Pressure-pipe a coconut where the leaves meet the trunk.
(Let it crust for a minute)



Brown PIPING

21. Pressure-pipe two more coconuts below the first one.



Pink PIPING

22. Pipe three curvy lines below the coconuts (as shown).



Red PIPING

23. Pressure-pipe a few small hearts along the pink lines you previously piped.



Pink PIPING

24. Pipe some small dots along the surface of the curved pink lines.
