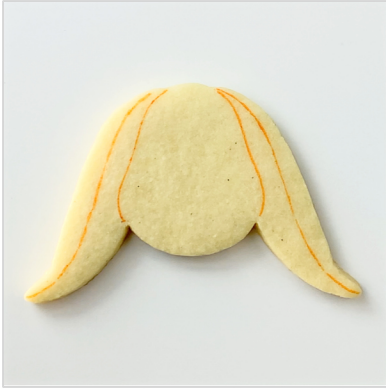

Decorating Guide

Bunny Head



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.
(More details in video)



Khaki PIPING

2. Outline the head.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe a border around one ear. Repeat for the other ear.



Khaki PIPING

4. Pipe along the midline of one ear. Repeat for the other ear.



Khaki PIPING

5. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the interior section of each ear.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

6. Fill in the interior section of each ear.



7. Allow your icing to dry or crust over.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

8. Fill in the head.



9. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.

Bunny Head (cont.)



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

10. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush. (**Watch video for full instruction)



White PIPING

11. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the outer section of each ear.



White FLOOD

12. Fill in the outer section of one ear.



Gray FLOOD

13. With a small opening in your bag touch down the tip against the still-wet white icing to create a series of little gray polka-dots.



White & Gray FLOOD

14. Repeat the previous two steps on the other ear.



15. Allow the icing to dry completely.



Black Edible Ink Pen

16. Draw two small, round ovals near the center line of the head. Draw two little curved lashes extending out from the top of each eye.



Khaki PIPING

17. Pipe two sets of stitch lines on the head, as shown.



Black PIPING

18. Pipe a small, vertical line in the middle of the face, near the bottom (below where the nose will go). You can also pipe over the ovals for the eyes to add more dimension.

Bunny Head (cont.)



Pink PIPING

19. Pipe a triangular outline for the nose, as shown.



Pink PIPING

20. Fill in the nose with piping icing, wiggling your tip along the surface to settle the icing.



All DONE!

** NOTE: You will make 4 versions of this same cookie. One of the 4 can be left as you see it here. For the other three, you will add a variety of additional accessories. The following guides will show you how to do so.

Bunny Head Accessories

Option 1 - Floral Headband



1. Start with one of your 4 original bunny head cookies.



Green PIPING

2. Pipe a curved line near the top of the head, from one edge to the other.



Green PIPING

3. Pipe a second curved line that intersects the first, as shown.

Option 1 - Floral Headband (cont.)



Yellow STIFF

- With your tip cut to an angled point, pipe a circle of overlapping petals to create a flower in the middle of the band.
(**Detailed info in the video)



White PIPING

- Pipe a cluster of white dots in the middle of the yellow flower.



Pink PIPING

- With your tip at the surface, pressure-pipe two dots, one on either side of the yellow flower.



Green STIFF

- Pipe small leaves along the length of the headband, both above and below it.
(**Detailed info in the video)



White PIPING

- Pipe some clusters of small white dots on each side of the headband.



Pink PIPING

- Pipe a small spiral from the center of each pink bud out to its edge.

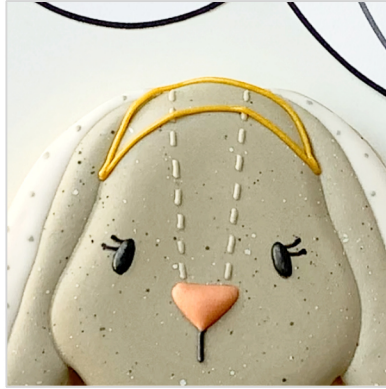

Option 2 - Knotted Headscarf



1. Start with one of your 4 original bunny head cookies.



Yellow PIPING

2. Pipe the outline for a curved band, bordering the top edge of the head.



Yellow PIPING

3. Pipe some crater-preventing squiggles inside the band.



Yellow FLOOD

4. Fill in the band.



5. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Yellow PIPING

6. Pipe an outline for one large knot and one small knot right next to each other.



Yellow PIPING

7. Outline tails for the scarf, one on each side of the knots.



Yellow PIPING

8. Fill in one knot and a non-adjacent tail with your tip right at the surface, wiggling to settle this thicker icing.
Allow to crust for ~1 minute.



Yellow PIPING

9. Fill in the second knot and second tail.

All DONE!

Option 3 - Knit Cap & Glasses



1. Start with one of your 4 original bunny head cookies.



Green PIPING

2. Pipe an outline for the lower band of the cap, as shown.



Green PIPING

3. Outline the top of the cap, piping along the top edge of the head.



Green PIPING

4. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the top section of the the cap.



Green FLOOD

5. Fill in the top of the cap.



6. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Green PIPING

7. Fill in the band of the cap, keeping your tip at the surface and wiggling to settle this thicker icing.



Black PIPING

8. Place a piece of parchment over your template (tape down if necessary) and pipe an outline for the inner and outer edges of the glasses.



Black PIPING

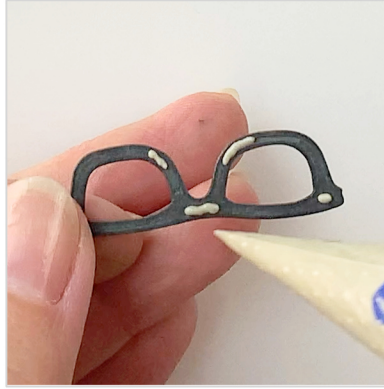
9. Immediately fill in the frame of the glasses with piping icing, wiggling as you work to settle the icing.
Set this 'icing transfer' aside to let it dry completely.

Option 3 - Knit Cap & Glasses (cont.)



Green PIPING

10. Pipe small vertical lines along the length of the cap's band, as shown.



Khaki PIPING

11. When the glasses 'icing transfer' is completely dry, pipe spots of icing on the reverse-side. This will act as a type of glue.



Khaki PIPING

12. Flip the transfer over and gently adhere it to the cookie, adding more icing under any elevated edges if needed.

Bunny Top - Gray Vest



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.

2. Outline each hand below the sleeve.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each hand.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each hand.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Gray PIPING

7. Pipe an outline around the left side of the vest.



Gray PIPING

8. Pipe an outline around the right side of the vest.



White PIPING

9. Outline each arm, including the top and inside edges.

Bunny Top - Gray Vest (cont.)



White PIPING

10. Pipe a border along the top of the cookie at the neckline and at the bottom below the vest.



White PIPING

11. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the sections shown.



White FLOOD

12. Fill in one arm.



Gray PIPING

13. Pipe pairs of horizontal stripes in the still-wet white icing.



White FLOOD & Gray PIPING

14. Repeat the previous two steps on the other arm and the upper and lower shirt sections.



15. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



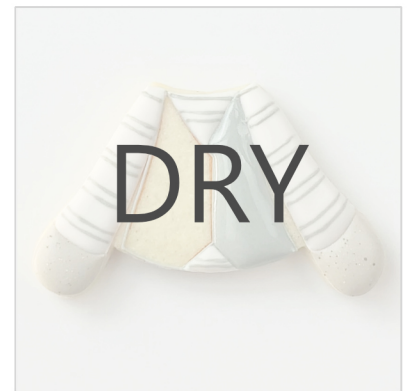
Gray PIPING

16. Pipe squiggles inside the right side of the vest.



Gray FLOOD

17. Fill in the right side of the vest.



18. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.

Bunny Top - Gray Vest (cont.)



Gray PIPING

19. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the left side of the vest.

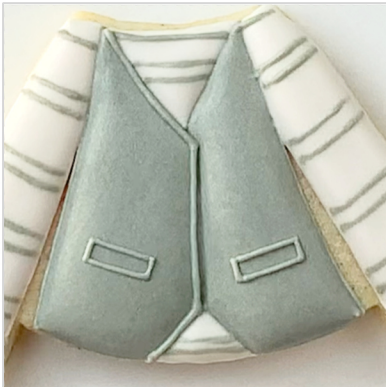


Gray FLOOD

20. Fill in the left side of the vest.



21. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Gray PIPING

22. Pipe a border along the inside edge of the left side of the vest. Also pipe small rectangles for pockets on each side of the vest.



Yellow PIPING

23. Outline the center knot and both side of the bow tie along the top edge of the cookie.



Yellow PIPING

24. Pipe squiggles inside all three sections of the bow tie.



Yellow FLOOD

25. Fill in the center knot of the bow tie.



White FLOOD

26. Pipe small white dots in the still-wet yellow icing.



Yellow & White FLOOD

27. Repeat the two previous steps for both sides of the bow tie.

All DONE!

Bunny Top - Pink Cardigan



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.
(More details in video)



Khaki PIPING

2. Outline each arm below the sleeve.



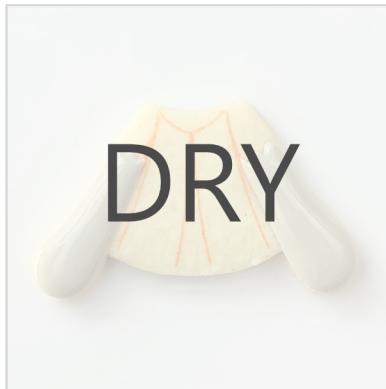
Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each arm.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each arm.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Pink PIPING

7. Outline each sleeve, piping along the edge of the cookie at the top.



Pink PIPING

8. Pipe a curved line along the neckline of the cardigan.



Pink PIPING

9. Outline each side of the cardigan, piping the bottom borders along the bottom edge of the cookie.

Bunny Top - Pink Cardigan (cont.)



Gray PIPING

10. Pipe a border along the top of the cookie at the neckline and at the bottom edge in the space between the cardigan sides.



Gray and Pink PIPING

11. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the colors and sections shown.



Gray FLOOD

12. Fill in both shirt sections, at the top and bottom.



Pink FLOOD

13. Fill in both sleeves.



14. Be sure that the gray icing is completely dry before the next step (as you'll be painting on it).



White gel and fine-tip brush

15. With watered-down white gel and a fine-tip brush, paint thin horizontal stripes on the shirt.



Pink PIPING

16. Pipe squiggles within each side of the cardigan.



Pink FLOOD

17. Fill in both sides of the cardigan.



18. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.

Bunny Top - Pink Cardigan (cont.)



Yellow PIPING

19. Pipe a border along the inside edge of each side of the cardigan as well as along the wavy end of each sleeve.



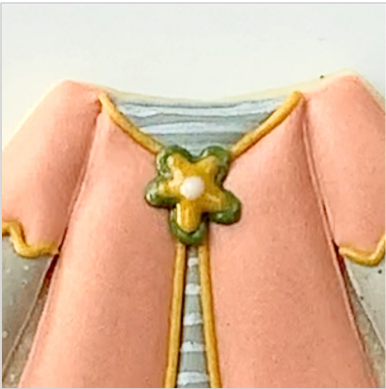
Green PIPING

20. Outline a small floral shape at the top of the cardigan.



Yellow PIPING

21. Fill in the floral outline with piping icing, wiggling it as you work in order to settle it.



White FLOOD

22. Pipe a small dot in the middle of the still-wet yellow icing.



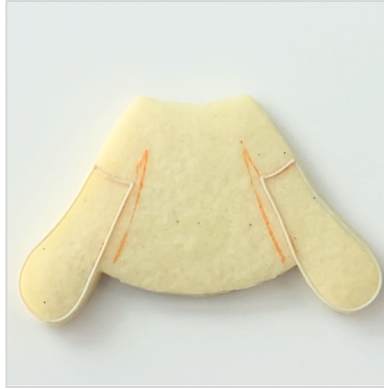

Bunny Top - Sweater with Scarf



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.

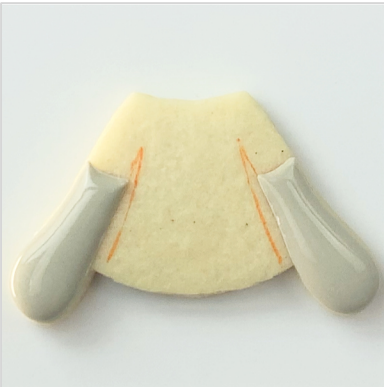
Khaki PIPING

2. Outline each arm below the sleeve.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each arm.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each arm.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Yellow PIPING

7. Outline the sweater, piping right along the edges of the cookie where applicable.



Yellow FLOOD

8. Fill in the sweater, being careful not to overflow the icing at the armpits.



9. Allow your icing to dry or crust over.

Bunny Top - Sweater with Scarf (cont.)



Yellow PIPING

10. Pipe two parallel lines at the end of each sleeve.



White PIPING

11. Outline the four sections of the scarf as shown, piping right along the top edge of the cookie.



White PIPING

12. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles in the middle of the long tail of the scarf.



White FLOOD

13. Fill in the long tail of the scarf.



Black PIPING

14. In the still-wet white icing pipe black stripes (pipe two lines next to each other for a wider stripe).



Yellow STIFF

15. Pipe a cable-knit pattern down the middle of the sweater. (*Watch video for full details)



Yellow PIPING

16. Pipe two lines on each side of the cable-knit pattern, as well as small vertical lines along the end of each sleeve, (between the existing lines).



White PIPING

17. Pipe squiggles inside each remaining scarf section.



White FLOOD & Black PIPING

18. Follow Steps 13/14 to fill in the remaining striped scarf sections, as shown. Start with the small tail, then the top right and finally the top left.

Bunny Top - Pocket Shirt



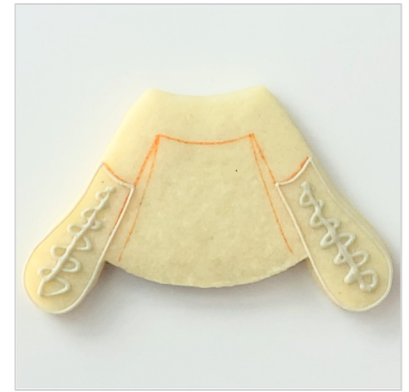

Khaki PIPING

2. Outline each arm below the sleeve.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each arm.

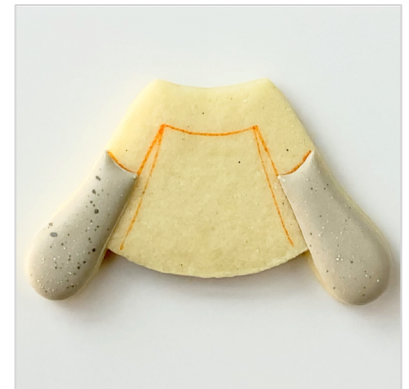


Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each arm.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Gray PIPING

7. Outline the lower bib-section of the shirt, including along the bottom edge of the cookie.



White PIPING

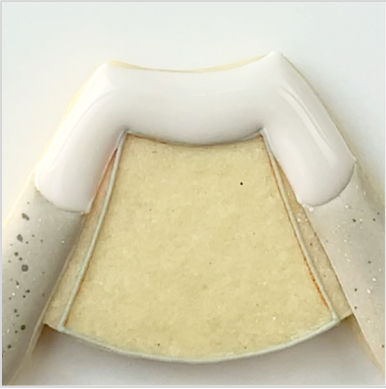
8. Outline the upper shirt area, including the inside edge of the sleeves and along the top edge of the cookie.



White PIPING

9. Pipe squiggles inside the upper shirt area.

Bunny Top - Pocket Shirt (cont.)



White FLOOD

10. Fill in the upper shirt area.



Green FLOOD

11. Pipe small dots in the still-wet white icing. Pipe clusters of dots as shown or create your own pattern.



12. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Gray FLOOD

13. Fill in the bib section of the shirt.



14. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Green PIPING

15. Pipe a single-line border at the bottom of each sleeve.



Gray PIPING

16. Pipe a border along the top edge of the gray bib.



Gray PIPING

17. Pipe outlines for two straps between the top edge of the bib and the upper edge of the cookie.



Gray PIPING

18. Fill in each strap, wiggling the tip of your bag as you go in order to settle this thicker icing.

Bunny Top - Pocket Shirt (cont.)



Gray PIPING

19. Pipe two small ovals for knots near the top edge of the bib.



Gray PIPING

20. Outline a curved pocket on the bottom half of the bib.



Gray PIPING

21. Pipe squiggles in the middle of the pocket.



Gray FLOOD

22. Fill in the pocket.



Gray PIPING

23. Pressure-pipe small tails below each of the knots on the bib. (**Make sure the bib has at least crusted before the next step)



Pink PIPING

24. Outline and immediately fill (with the same icing) the tops of three carrots emerging from the pocket.



Green PIPING

25. Pipe small stems emerging from the top of each carrot, similar to what's shown.



Green PIPING

26. Pipe dots for small round leaves along the stems.



Gray PIPING

27. Pipe a line of stitches along the top edge of the pocket.

Bunny Pants - Green Corduroy



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.

Khaki PIPING

2. Outline each leg between the bottom of the pants and tops of the shoes.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each leg.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each leg.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Green PIPING

7. Outline the pants, being sure to pipe right along the top and side edges of the cookie.



Gray PIPING

8. Outline each shoe.



Gray PIPING

9. Pipe squiggles inside each shoe.

Bunny Pants - Green Corduroy (cont.)



Green FLOOD

10. Fill in the pants.



Gray FLOOD

11. Fill in each shoe.



12. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Green PIPING

13. Pipe small, half-oval flaps on either side of each shoe.



Green PIPING

14. Pipe a curved line as a waistband just below the top edge of the cookie.



Green PIPING

15. Pipe a series of vertical lines on top of the pants to create a corduroy look.



Green PIPING

16. Fill in each shoe flap, wiggling the tip of your bag as you go in order to settle this thicker icing.



Gray PIPING & Black PIPING

17. Pipe a border along the top edge of each shoe with gray icing. Pipe a pair of black lines connecting each shoe flap.



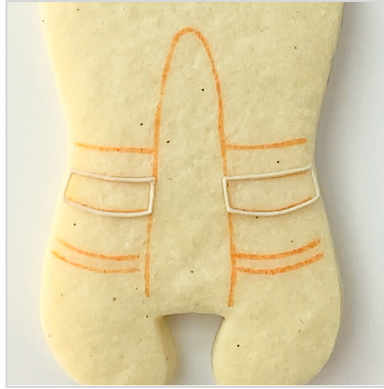

Bunny Pants - Gray Linen

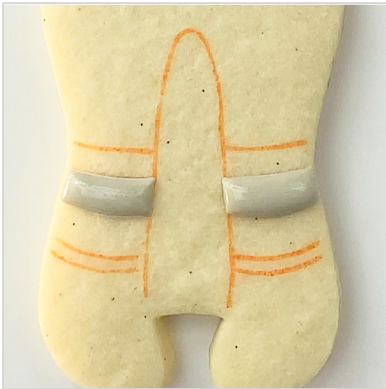
Khaki PIPING

2. Outline the small segment of each leg that's just below the bottom of the pant cuffs.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each leg.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each leg.

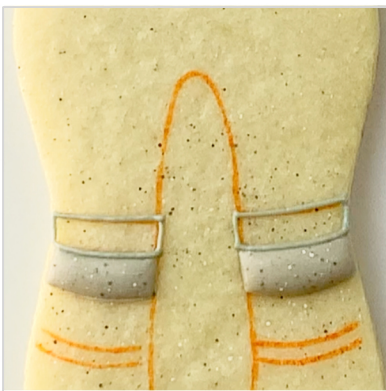


5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



Gray PIPING

7. Outline the bottom cuff of each pant leg.



Gray PIPING

8. Outline the main section of the pants, including the inseam.



White PIPING

9. Outline the socks, as shown.

Bunny Pants - Gray Linen (cont.)



Pink PIPING

10. Outline the sections that border the top edge of the shoes.



Yellow PIPING

11. Outline each shoe.



White & Yellow PIPING

12. Pipe white squiggles inside each sock and yellow squiggles inside each shoe.



Gray FLOOD

13. Fill in the main section of the pants.



White FLOOD

14. Fill in the socks.



Yellow FLOOD

15. Fill in the shoes.



16. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Gray PIPING

17. Fill in the cuff of each pant leg, wiggling the tip as you work in order to settle this thicker icing.



Pink PIPING

18. Fill in the top border of each shoe, wiggling the tip as you work in order to settle this thicker icing.

Bunny Pants - Gray Linen (cont.)



White gel and fine-tip brush

19. Using watered-down white gel, paint a series of thin intersecting lines to create a crosshatch or linen look. (**Gray icing should be fully dried before painting)



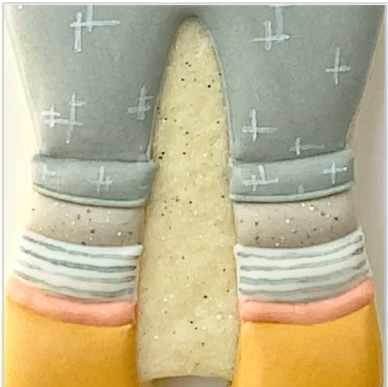
Stone gel and fine-tip brush

20. Add a small amount of stone gel to the paint mixture from Step 19. Paint thin horizontal lines on the white socks.



Gray PIPING

21. Pipe a line for the waistband just a bit below the top edge of the cookie.



Gray PIPING

22. Pipe a border along the bottom edge of each cuff to add a little dimension.



Yellow PIPING

23. Pipe a border along the top edge of each yellow shoe.



Yellow PIPING

24. Pipe a line of stitch marks just below the line you last piped on each shoe.



Yellow PIPING

25. Pipe two small dots as buttons on the waistband.

Bunny Skirt - White Floral



Food Marker

1. Use a food marker along with either your projector or paper templates to mark guides on your cookie.
(More details in video)



Khaki PIPING

2. Outline each leg, as well as the interior section of each shoe.



Khaki PIPING

3. Pipe crater-preventing squiggles inside each leg.



Khaki MEDIUM (20 sec.)

4. Fill in each leg.



5. Allow your icing to dry completely before moving on to the next step.



White Gel, Taupe Gel, Water, Brush

6. With watered-down white and taupe gels, speckle your icing using a tight-bristled brush.
(**Watch video for full instruction)



White PIPING

7. Outline the skirt, being sure to pipe lines along each crease.



White PIPING

8. Outline the strap of each shoe.



White PIPING

9. Outline the bottom edge of each shoe.

Bunny Skirt - White Floral (cont.)



White PIPING

10. Pipe squiggles inside each section of the shoes.



White FLOOD

11. Fill in the skirt, being careful not to overflow the icing at the creases.



Pink FLOOD

12. Pipe three-petal floral shapes in the still-wet icing, as shown.



Yellow FLOOD

13. With the white icing of the skirt still wet, pipe some additional yellow flowers.



White FLOOD

14. Fill in the bottom section of the shoes.

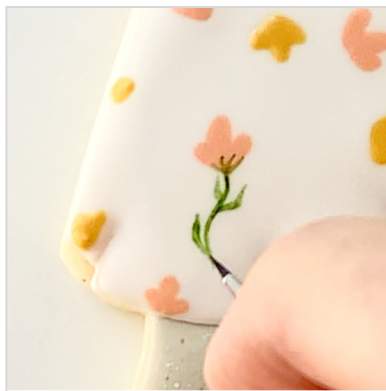


15. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



White FLOOD

16. Fill in the strap of each shoe.



Dijon, Forest Green, Terracotta gels

17. Mix gels with water to create a green paint. With a fine-tip brush, paint a curved stem with leaves beneath a flower.



Dijon, Forest Green, Terracotta gels

18. Repeat Step 17 for all of the flowers, curving the stems to fill in any large white spaces on the skirt.

Bunny Skirt - White Floral (cont.)



White PIPING

19. Pipe a curved line for the waistband just below the top edge of the cookie.



White PIPING

20. Accentuate the creases of the skirt by piping some additional lines on top of the creases and bottom edge of the skirt (as shown).



Yellow PIPING

21. Pipe small circles for buttons on the outside edge of each shoe strap.

Bunny Skirt - Pink with Pockets

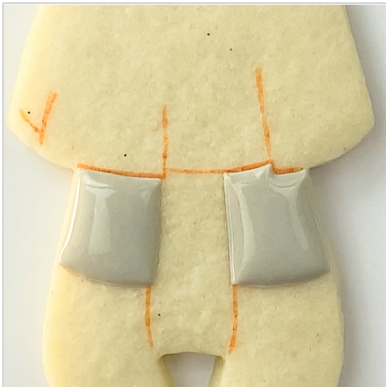

Pink FLOOD

10. Fill in the skirt, being careful not to overflow the icing at the creases.



Yellow FLOOD

11. Fill in each shoe.



12. Allow the icing to dry or crust over.



Yellow PIPING

13. Pipe two adjacent lines at the top edge of each shoe.



Yellow PIPING

14. Create tassels on each shoe by piping lines of varying length down from the top edge.



Yellow PIPING

15. Pipe a small rectangular shape along one edge of the skirt.



Yellow PIPING

16. Pipe a mirror image of the shape from Step 15 on the opposite side of the skirt and fill in both with the same piping icing.



White PIPING

17. Outline curved pockets just below the bands from the previous steps.



White FLOOD

18. Fill in one pocket.

Bunny Skirt - Pink with Pockets (cont.)



Yellow PIPING

19. Pipe thin lines in the still-wet icing of the pocket.



White FLOOD & Yellow PIPING

20. Repeat the two previous steps for the other pocket.



Pink PIPING

21. Pipe a curved line for the waistband just below the top edge of the cookie.



Pink PIPING

22. Accentuate the creases of the skirt by piping some additional lines on top of the creases and bottom edge of the skirt (as shown).



All DONE!
